- Then to Sidra Almuntaha Lote tree. Sidrat al-Muntaha → Tree, leaves, butterflies, its beauty is beyond explaination
 - It's roots are in the sixth heaven, and the tree reaches up to the seventh heaven.
 - Leaves size of the elephant ears; fruits size of large jar. Great river with great taste come out of it trunk.
 - It's size is so big that speedy rider would walk one hundred of year in its shade and wont cross it.
 - It is covered by golden butterflies and green light. Angels around it making Tasbeeh.
 - Three main properties: Long shade, the good taste; the nice odor.
 - At the base of the sidratul are four rivers.
 - Euphrates and Nile (in the world)
 - Kauthar and Sal Sabeel (in Jannah)
 - At the Sidra-ul-Muntaha, Prophet (peace be upon him) saw angel Jibril in its real form.

Holy Journey in Summary

Worship of Angels

- Beautiful gift Salah.
- 9 visits (back and forth) because of dialog with Musa (AS)



Signs on Miraaj

- He saw the hellfire and saw the angels of hellfire.
- He saw the Jannah, Paradise
- Paradise \rightarrow most of inhabitants were poor.
 - Hur ul-In: females
 - − wildan ul-mukhalladun → 10,000 of them with everyone

Signs were shown to him in Asra

- 1. Allah enabled the Prophet to see the **world (dunya) like an old woman.** However, this old woman was wearing a great deal of jewelry, and in this there is an indication signifying the reality of the world
- 2. Prophet **smelled very nice odor** : A long story of Pharos's daugher's slave.
- 3. Prophet saw **people who were planting and reaping in two days.** "These were the people who fight for the sake of Allah.
- 4. saw people whose lips and tongues were clipped with scissors made of fire. Jibril told the Prophet, "These are the speakers of sedition (fitna) who call people to misguidance
- 5. He also saw a **bull which exited a very small** outlet, then was trying in vain to return through that small outlet. Jibril told the Prophet, "This is the example of the bad word-once spoken, it cannot be returned."

Signs were shown to him in Asra-2

- 1. The Prophet saw people grazing like animals, with very little clothing on their private parts. Jibril told the Prophet, "These are the ones who refused to pay zakat. "
- 2. The Prophet saw angels **smashing some people's heads with rocks.** These heads would return to the shape they had been, and then the angels would smash their heads again the ones who used to sleep without praying.
- 3. saw people who were **competing to eat some rotten meat**-ignoring meat. Jibril told the Prophet, "These are people that which is permissible (halal), and consume that which is forbidden (haram) fornicators
- 4. saw people who were drinking from the fluid coming from the bodies of the fornicators, (water mixed with blood). who were drinking the alcohol which is prohibited in this world
- 5. saw people scratching their faces and chests with brass finger nails. Jibril said, "These are the examples of those who commit gossip.

Next day Holy Journey

- Next day he (peace be upon him) said the incident
- He (peace be upon him) was ordered to tell the everyone in Makkah
- Incident of Abu Bakr Siddique and his title assignment
- Imam Qustalani: Stupid questions of Kufar next day of Miraj (when Huzoor explained his journey)
 - Tell us how many Windows, and holes
 - Tell how many caravans coming to Makkah (Hazoor explained the colors of the Camel saddles or clothes
 - One at the Sun rise, One at the mid day, One at the sun set
 - Abu Bakr and Omer were on one side, Kuffar on the other side
